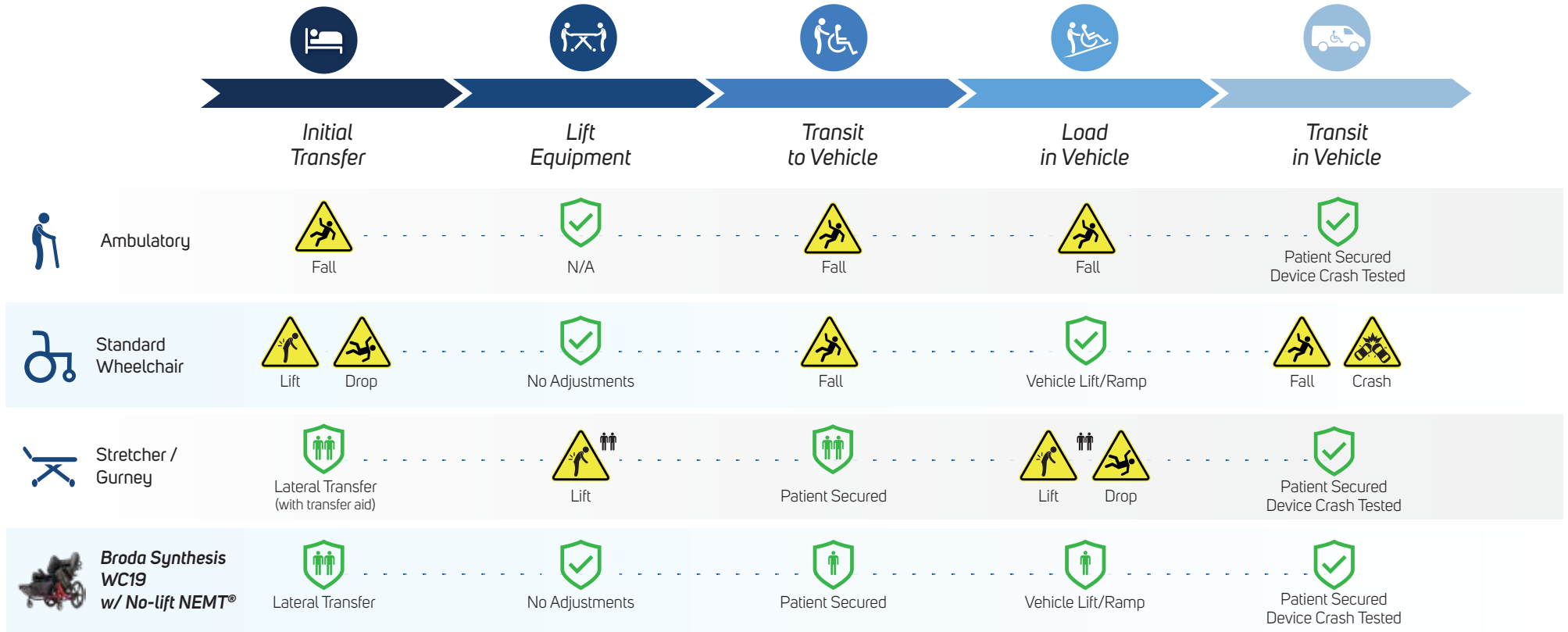


# Risk Mitigation

How and where does No-lift NEMT reduce risk in transport?

## Medical Transport Risk Timeline

Five high-risk events occur in the medical transport process. With the right equipment and techniques these risks can be mitigated significantly. The table below highlights standard transport devices & practices--and the risk involved with each.



- Mitigated Risk** - The nature of the process significantly reduces risk.
- Mitigated Risk** - A two-person operation which significantly reduces risk.
- Fall or Submarine Risk** - Risk of patient falling or sliding out of wheelchair.
- Drop Risk** - Risk of a patient being dropped or gurney tipping over.
- Lifting** - Risk of back or other injury to staff due to lifting patient or device.
- Collision Risk** - Increased risk of injury in the event of collision or abnormal driving.
- Mitigated Risk** - A one-person operation which significantly reduces risk.
- Mitigated Risk** - A two-person operation
